Computation of Merit: Merit will be determined on the basis of 30 percent weightage to be given to NTS based Entry Test Marks and 70 percent weightage to marks obtained in F.A/F.Sc. or equivalent including 20 marks for Hafiz-e-Quran and 5 marks each for Computer-A / Computer-B /Computer-G subjects studied at Intermediate level.
